How to register your child in school

Frequently Asked Questions

Question: What if my child has not seen a doctor/dentist in the time frame requirement?

Answer: Your child(ren) may still enroll and attend school, however, paperwork and documentation must be completed within 30 days of registration.

Question: What if I have not received a utility bill/statement for my new residence?

Answer: Your child(ren) may still enroll and attend school, however, paperwork and documentation must be completed within 30 days of registration.

Question: Will my child receive bussing?

Answer: You should expect communication from your child(ren)'s school regarding eligibility of transportation prior to their first day of school.

Question: My child is in K-4th grade. Will they attend Lindenwold #4 or Lindenwold #5?

Answer: Elementary students are enrolled using a Zoning Map. In general, the White Horse Pike is the dividing line in town. The north side of the White Horse Pike attend School #4, and the

south side will attend School #5. However, there are some exceptions. Exceptions to the Zoning Map are below. These apartment communities attend Lindenwold #5 due to equitable distribution.

Question: Will my child be able to attend before/after care?

Question: When will I be contacted for Kindergarten screening?

Answer: You should expect Kindergarten screening to occur during the Spring months leading to September.

Question: When will I be contacted for Preschool lottery results?

Answer: You should expect to receive your lottery status prior to July 1.

Question: My child received special services at their previous school. Will that continue in Lindenwold?

Answer: Please bring a current copy of student IEP/504. The Child Study Team will be in contact after reviewing your documents.

Question: My child is interested in taking specific courses in Middle/High School. How can I ensure they will have Honors/AP/electives in their schedule?

Answer: Your child(ren)'s guidance counselor will be in contact shortly to discuss course selection.
